

Post Doctoral Fellowship in Sport & Exercise Medicine & Rehabilitation: Stellenbosch University

Job description

A joint postdoctoral position in Sport & Exercise Medicine and Rehabilitation is available at the Institute of Sport and Exercise Medicine, and the Physiotherapy Division, Faculty of Medicine and Health Science (Tygerberg campus), Stellenbosch University. The area of postdoctoral research will be in the prevention and control of non-communicable disease through lifestyle interventions within a primary healthcare setting. A specific sub-project will investigate the effects of exercise training in patients with multiple co-morbidities. Applicants should have obtained a PhD degree in the past 5 years and have a strong background in the rehabilitation of medical populations. A good clinical understanding of injury prevention and management; as well as exercise prescription in chronic disease is required.
